Mary Lee Krinsky, D.O. is a Professor of Medicine at the University of California San Diego School of Medicine and a nationally recognized interventional endoscopist at UC San Diego Health. Her clinical and research interests focus on the endoscopic management of gastrointestinal cancers and pancreaticobiliary disease, as well as endoscopic innovation, quality, and ergonomics. Dr. Krinsky completed her general gastroenterology fellowship at Yale University and advanced endoscopy fellowship at Columbia University. She serves on the editorial review board for Gastrointestinal Endoscopy and the NIH/NIDDK Data and Safety Monitoring Board for the Type I Diabetes in Acute Pancreatitis Consortium. She is a co-founder of the Association of Women Endoscopists, through which she leads international medical outreach missions, learning exchanges to advance global GI care, and collaborative endoscopy courses.
