Dr. Carlos Robles-Medranda is an Ecuadorian gastroenterologist and endoscopist, member of the ASGE, AGA, ACG, ESGE, among other international societies. He is deeply passionate about digestive endoscopy, with a special interest in EUS, confocal laser endomicroscopy, cholangioscopy, POEM, ERCP, and other state-of-the-art endoscopic procedures. He serves as Head of the Endoscopy Unit at the Instituto Ecuatoriano de Enfermedades Digestivas (IECED) and as Director of the Pentax Training Center Ecuador (PTCE), accredited by the WEO and ASGE in Latin America, where more than 100 professionals worldwide have been trained in advanced interventional endoscopy.

He currently serves as an Editor of Endoscopy International Open, the official scientific journal of the European Society of Gastrointestinal Endoscopy (ESGE). Dr. Robles-Medranda has authored multiple internationally recognized scientific studies. His most recent awards include “The Glaciomar Machado Award” at ENDO 2024 in Seoul, South Korea—making him a three-time global champion in this category—and the National Scholar Award at UEG Week in 2024, 2013, and 2018. He also received the Best Paper Award at the World Congress of Gastroenterology 2017 (Functional Disorders), Second Best Paper Award at ENDO 2020, Technological Innovation of the Year at ESGE Days 2021, and the “Best Abstract: Meinhard Classen Award” at ENDO 2022.

Additionally, he was awarded Best Communication in Pancreas and Biliary Diseases at SEPD 2023, as well as Distinguished Scientific Work of the Year and Best Scientific Paper (Oral Presentation) at the Argentine National Congress of Gastroenterology in 2023 and 2024. He obtained his Medical Degree from the Catholic University of Guayaquil (2003), completed his postgraduate training at the Federal University of Rio de Janeiro (2005), his EUS training at the Mediterranean University of Marseille (2006–2007), and his specialization in Interventional Endoscopy at Claude Bernard University of Lyon (2006–2008).
